There are two program options at Pathways:

01 HiSET - High School Equivalency Diploma

Students take HiSET Prep courses in Math, English, Social Studies, and Science in addition to Pathways work-ready courses in Welding, Carpentry, or Business.


02 Smart Horizons Online High School Diploma

How do I apply to Pathways Success Center?

Meet with your School Counselor to fill out the online application.

Do I have to enroll in a Livingston Parish Public School to apply?

What is the HiSET?

High School Equivalency Test

Will I get my high school diploma?

If you choose the HSE program, you will earn a High School Equivalency diploma. If you choose the Smart Horizons program, you will receive an online high school diploma.

Can I participate in graduation at my home-based school?

Please speak to the person in charge of graduation at your home-based school.

How long does the Pathways program take?

It varies for each student depending on age, grade level, and experience. The HSE program should take no more than 2 years. Smart Horizons has a limit of 18 months.



General Information:

- Students must be at least 16 years old and have a valid, government issued ID to take the HiSET
- The HiSET is on a 6th grade reading level
- Students must be 16 years old to begin the Smart Horizons program
- SH does accept previously earned high school credits (please provide transcript)
- Once an application is received, a Pathways team member will call to set up grade-level testing and an interview
- Once accepted, bus service is provided to and from the home-based school
